There are electric heaters and multi pane wooden single glazed windows throughout the property. B4RN, the high speed rural internet and a BT phone line are currently connected to the property.


Externally there is parking one car on a gravelled drive, an orchard garden, low shed for outside storage and patio area with room for a table and chairs.
