



Steeped in history Abergavenny was originally a Roman Fort then a medieval walled town. It is now a market town with arguably more life than nearby Usk and Monmouth. It offers a wide range of amenities with major supermarkets, weekly retail and farmers markets, a high street comprising of recognized chains and local department stores, leisure centre, a number of churches and Nevill Hall Hospital. Its location means that Abergavenny acts as the major transport hub for the area. The railway station allows easy access to anywhere on the rail network. The A465, Heads of the Valleys Road is one mile out of town with the M50 / M4 a further 25 minutes away. Furthermore there is a large bus station with an extensive range of routes to neighbouring towns and villages and as far afield as Cardiff.
