


Situated in the ever popular Hanover conservation area, the property is within walking distance of excellent local shopping on Lewes Road, the renovated Open Market, the Level with its fantastic open spaces, Skate Park and the architecturally award-winning Velo cafe. Brighton beach and the North Lanes area with an extensive range of independent shops are also within easy walking distance. Looking for an evening out? The Duke of York's Picture house is one of the best in the UK along with great local pubs serving good food and the Theatre Royal being approx. 20 minute walk away as is Brighton station can be reached on foot as also is London Road station for trains to Lewes and Eastbourne. There are frequent bus services passing close by proving easy access to all parts of Brighton and Hove. The ever popular Hanover area itself is home to an eclectic mix of independent shopping, cafes and pubs, while the nearby schools are well-regarded. 














Second Floor Area: 21.0 m² ... 226 ft²






First Floor
